

Signal Hill School Dress Code

At Signal Hill, we respect each other, ourselves, and the learning environment. Clothing worn in our school should reflect these values.

1. Hoods, and sunglasses should be removed upon entry to the school building.
2. Footwear must be worn at all times and should be appropriate for school activities. Students must wear indoor shoes when they are inside the school.
3. Images and writing on clothing should be respectful and should not display any negative or inappropriate messages.
4. Underwear should not be visible.
5. Tank tops and shirts should not reveal cleavage or midriffs.
6. Shorts and skirts need to be long enough to completely cover the buttocks.

The school dress code was created with the input of teachers, administration, and Grade 6 and 7 students. It applies to all students and staff in the school. If there is a disagreement about whether or not a certain article of clothing violates the school dress code, the Principal or Vice-Principal shall make the final decision. A person who is violating the school dress code will be asked to change.
